Secondary Metals Recycler Registration Form

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 10-1-359.1, secondary metals recyclers who purchase regulated metal property in any quantity must register with the appropriate Sheriff's office or offices.

To Determine the County of Registration

• LEGAL ENTITY (e.g. Business, Corporation, or Partnership)

You must register with the Sheriff in each county where you maintain a place of business. If you maintain a place of business in more than one county, you must file a separate registration form for each business location.

- INDIVIDUAL/SOLE PROPRIETOR (Georgia Resident)
 - You must register in the county where you reside.
- INDIVIDUAL/SOLE PROPRIETOR (Non-Resident of Georgia)

You must register in the county where you primarily engage or intend to engage in business as a secondary metals recycler.

The Registration Process

- Obtain a copy of the *Secondary Metals Recycler Registration* form online at www.decaturso.com or by visiting the Decatur County Sheriff's Office.
- Complete and submit the registration form *in person* to the appropriate Sheriff's office or offices.
- Application for registration must include:

□ Non-Refundable Registration Fee. Submit payment of \$200 with the registration form. Payment must be made in the
form of a check or money order payable to the Decatur County Sheriff's Office. Checks returned for insufficient funds
are subject to a \$30 service charge pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 16-9-20.

☐ Background Check. Applicable to any person applying in this county as a new Registered Agent on or after July 1,
2023 -OR—any Registered Agent of an existing Secondary Metals Recycler whose registration is expired as of July 1,
2023, or following any term thereafter, at a fee not to exceed \$75. Not applicable to renewals unless the registration is
expired.
